

Oil tankers are large specially designed ships which only carry oil over water.

The cost of tankers moving oil is around 2 or 3 cents per gallon.

Worldwide, tankers carry around 2 billion barrels of oil each year



Over the last 250 years oil tankers have become much safer and now experience much less risk of crashing and spilling their oil.


Oil pipelines are designed to carry oil over land.

Pipelines offer the cheapest way to transport oil over long distances at around 3% of the cost of the oil.

Oil pipelines transport more oil each year than any other method.
