- Can book out group study rooms
- Mention how the library is now open 24 hours during exams
- Academic skills hub and writing centre located in library
- Help available at the desk for all queries

# **Building 28- Take the students to outside building 28**

- Classes often held in this building
- Few more offices on top of the classrooms

## Student Services- stop outside the building

- Visa issues
- Private tuition fees payments
- Careers services office
- Tempbank office, temporary job listings
- Any kind of issues

# **Chaplaincy- Briefly point out**

#### Jubilee sports centre- Stop outside the building

- Gym, Sports halls, Swimming pool, Squash courts, Bouldering wall, cycling studio
- Membership £230 per year for everything
- £165 for yearly membership, excludes peak times
- Can pay monthly
- Sport and wellbeing membership may be needed for sport societies
- Open early until late during university terms

## Redbrick - Stop on the redbrick outside stags

- Point out Stags, watch the major sports events, karaoke Thursdays is most popular night, check union website for events, cheap alcohol
- Point towards the Piazza, Open all day serving selection of hot and cold food
- The shop, upstairs is the unilink office for bus problems/ lost passes, clothing shop upstairs
- Fruit and veg market every monday

# Students union- Go inside the students union building

 A number of facilities are provided at the Union building. Some examples could include the cinema, cube, diner, cafe, old sports centre, lettings service, box office and the bridge.
