<p>You can decide whether the final output is a presentation or a written report *amend the text on the PowerPoint and worksheet accordingly*</p> <p>The worksheet contains instructions of how to put together the case studies, using various resources.</p> <p>These projects could be easily extended and converted into EPQ projects by providing more detail/more thorough analysis of the existing dataset or by extending the range of data evaluated.</p> <p>The two types of case study are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Geographic reach and trade routes of port towns - Socio-economic position of shipmasters <p>**The worksheet contains links to useful resources so it may be helpful to have the students pull up the worksheet on the PC, rather than printing it.**</p> <p>They may need to print maps on which to plot their data – links to these maps are contained in the worksheet.</p>
