Open Access Jargon Buster

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Hybrid Journal: a subscription journal containing a mix of both open access and paywalled content. Many of our publisher agreements are designed to help hybrid journals transition to full open access and are usually supported by open access block grants.

Institutional Repository: an archive for collecting, preserving, and disseminating digital copies of the research outputs of an institution. ePrints Soton is the University of Southampton's

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ORCID ID: This is a unique researcher ID. It helps avoid confusion between researchers with the same or similar names. ORCID stands for **Open Researcher and Contributor IDentifier**.

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REF: Research Excellence Framework, the system for assessing the quality of research in UK higher education institutions.

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Subscription journal: a subscription journal contains paywalled content. Also known as a hybrid journal. University users will often have access to a journal as the University has purchased a subscription.

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Version of Record (VoR): Version of Record (VoR) is also known as the definitive, authorised, formal, or published version, although these terms may not be synonymous.
